



# RAINBOW TOURNAMENT



## Referee Plan

As indicated in the Rainbow Tournament Rules and Regulations, each accepted team is to provide 3 qualified referees, each one to cover a minimum of three assignments. A deposit of \$300.00 will be required from each team entering the tournament and will be refunded if all assignments are completed by the team's three referees. The referee deposit will be pro-rated and refunded for each assignment fulfilled and the tournament will keep pro-rated amounts equal to unfulfilled assignments. Deposit refunds for completed assignments will be mailed within 14 days following the end of the tournament to the Home Region address of record on the team application. Referees will be presented with a RBT hat and official tournament coin when given their first assignment.

The tournament will employ a diagonal system of control utilizing one center and two assistant referees. All three referees should be capable of handling their assigned positions (either C or AR) in the age group equivalent to the division in which his/her soccer team is competing. The Tournament Referee Administrator will do all assigning of referees to games, and referees from a particular team may or may not be assigned to the same game. Assignments will be made depending on the age group of the teams competing and the qualifications and experience of each referee assigned to that match. Assignments are by time slot and not by field or game. RBT assigns one more referee teams than there are games for each time slot. For example if 5 games are scheduled for 1:00pm, six referee teams will be assigned for that time slot. The referee team will be given their assignment when they check in at the referee tent. The "extra referee team" will be used to fill in any vacancies. Referee teams need to check in at the main referee tent in full uniform 30 minutes prior to their assigned time slot. Your team will be given credit even if they do not get an assignment. Failure to check in will result in pro-rata reduction in their teams referee deposit.

Any team advancing out of pool play must provide a qualified referee team of three for the playoffs. Failure to do so could result in forfeiture of part or all of the team's referee deposit.

Sportsmanship will be monitored by the referee crew who will rate the behavior of players, coaches and spectators in each game they officiate.

Referees for semi-final and final games for each age group will be assigned by the Rainbow Tournament Referee Administrator and/or his staff.

Teams advancing out of pool play will be required to provide a referee team of three for the playoffs. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of all or part of the referee deposit.**
